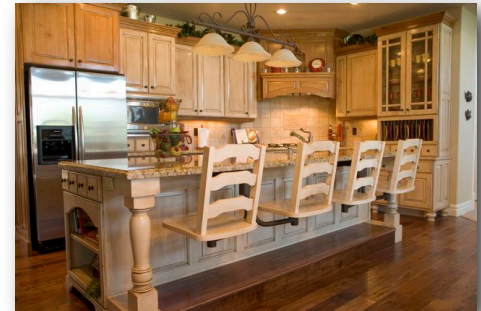
Succumbing to the Sizzle

Installation Tip

Spacing is the key

Spacing between chairs and the length of the countertop overhang can make the difference in terms of comfort and ease of access.

We recommend 27” spacing between most of our chair styles (minimum 24”).

The counter top overhang should be 15” (minimum 12”).

If your design varies from these recommendations, please let us know so we can discuss the options with you.
